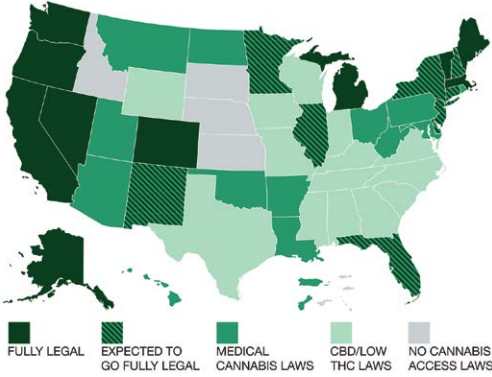
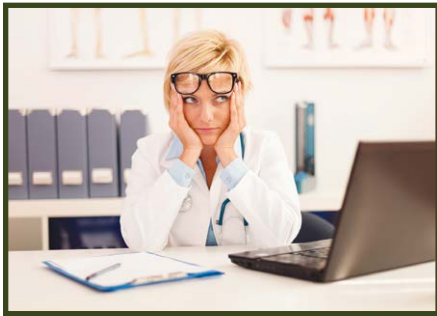
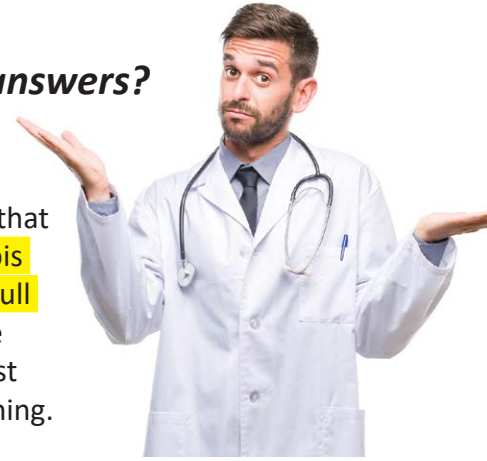


# Are You Prepared?

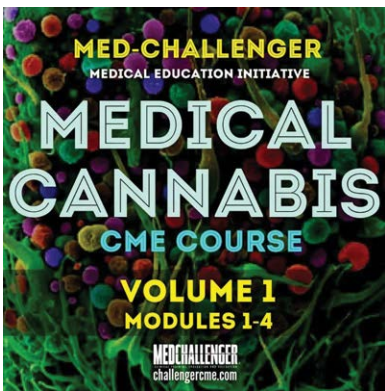

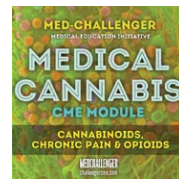

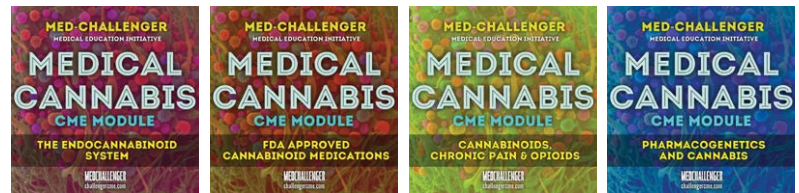
